You could:

- Ask: Add 80 and 30, tell me how you did it.
- Say: Tell me all the number pairs you know with multiples of 10 which make 90.
- Ask: What is the difference between 20 and 80?
- Say: Look at these multiples of 10.... Which pairs give a total of 100?
