## Maths

Please practise your **Multiplication facts: 9** ready for your **test on Friday**. This is about knowing all the multiplication facts in the nine times table. It is important that children can also use words other than 'times', e.g. lots of, multiplied by, sets of... You could: Say: What is the number before 54 in the 9x table? Or you could Say: What is the answer to 6x9? 9x9?

- 2) **Write a sentence for each of the words**. You can include more than one word in a sentence as long as it makes sense and shows that you understand the word.
