<p>Maths</p> <p>Please practise your RNR facts ready for your test on Friday.</p>	<p>Maths Rapid Recall: Target 6.1</p> <p>Double any number with up to 1 decimal place.</p> <p>This target is about being able to double a number with one decimal place, e.g. Double 5.4 is 10.8</p> <p>You could: Ask: Which number did you double to get the answer 3.8?
