Children will be asked to find four ways to make a number, using both addition and subtraction, e.g.</p> <p>Target number is 18</p> <p>So,</p> <p><b>10 + 8 = 18</b>  <b>8 + 10 = 18</b>  <b>18 – 10 = 8</b>  <b>18 – 8 = 10</b></p> <p>Speed test yourself.  <span style="color: red;">In your book, write your own rapid number recall of 24 calculations</span></p>
