Please practise your **times tables** ready for the times table test on **Monday**, and your **maths facts** ready for your test on **Friday**. This week the Friday test will be on **Know** all **decimals** that total **1** (up to **2** decimal places) **6.6. This target** is about knowing the pairs of numbers that add up to make **1**. This is really useful when dealing with money. **Example:** 0.27 + 0.73 = 1 This is useful to think of in pence adding up to one pound. You could think in terms of, and practise questions like: How much change will I have from £1 if I spend 29p?
