What Is The World Cup?

The World Cup is an international football tournament and involves football teams from around the world. It takes place every four years and was first held in 1930.

The World Cup can take place in any country around the world. In recent years, it has been held in Germany, South Africa and Brazil.



The World Cup 2018

In 2018, The World Cup will be held in Russia from 14th June to 15th July. It will be the first time that Russia has hosted The World Cup.

There will be 32 teams from around the world competing. They will play a total of 64 matches at 12 different football stadiums around Russia.



The teams will be split into eight groups of four teams. England is in Group G with Belgium, Panama and Tunisia.

All teams will play in the Group Stage matches. Then, the top two teams from each group will go through to the Knockout Stage. The best two teams will play in the final at the Luzhniki Stadium in Moscow.

The World Cup Emblem

The emblem (logo) for this year's World Cup is the shape of the World Cup trophy. It is red, gold, black and blue and was designed in a similar style to Russian art from the past.
