EYFS (Reception and Nursery)

We are very pleased that your children have now settled into our Reception and Nursery classes. We want to develop your child's independence so please say goodbye at the gate. They will then put their own belongings away and get ready to start learning promptly.

We want to keep your children safe and secure in school. Please do not try to come into the EYFS area when you are dropping your child off in the mornings. **This will help us to ensure that only people who have been checked, come into contact with your child.** It is important that when you come for "Stay and Play" sessions that you only go into your child's classroom and not the cloakroom or toilet areas. Again, we don't want to offend by asking you to leave these areas.

Supervision Before School

I am very happy to report that nearly every child in our school is arriving on time every day – this is great news!

However, some of the children are coming to school very early to play football in the MUGA. I have also had reports about children being brought to school by their parents and then leaving the school premises (where their parents think they are safe) to go to the shop or to collect their friends.

We do not have any adults in the playgrounds until 8.30am so there is no one to supervise them and keep them safe. If you need your child to be at school before 8.30am then they can join our breakfast club. It is £2 per day.

Please do not bring your child to school before 8.30am (unless it is for Breakfast Club)

Bikes in the playground

We have over 1000 people in the playground at the beginning and end of each school day. **Riding bikes and scooters in the playground is not allowed** because we want to prevent accidents. If you or your child rides their bike or their scooter in the playground they will be asked to get off and walk with it.

Harvest Festival

Thank you to all of you who have donated gifts for our harvest festival. You have all been most generous.

The children were asked by the House Captains to reflect on the food that they had been given and the people who provided it. Please talk to your child about the assembly this evening.

I have been asked by some parents if they can bring more items on Monday as they have forgotten. As we will not be taking the gifts until Monday afternoon, please feel free to bring in more gifts on Monday morning.
