Saturday School 9.30am to 11.30am

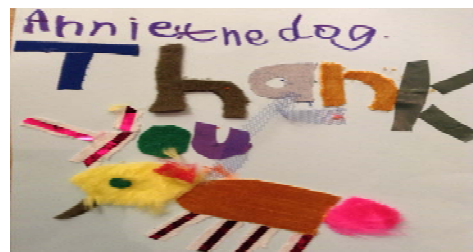
School Bags
