### **Head Lice**

Quite a lot of parents are complaining that their children are getting head lice. This is quite common in primary schools but easily treated if you check your child's head regularly each week with a "nit comb". If you comb and find a living louse then follow the instructions below:

**The best treatment is to use lotion\* (not shampoo and mousses) from the chemist. Your doctor may issue you with a prescription.**

**Always follow manufacturers' instructions on how to use the lotion\*. How long you leave the lotion\* on the head may vary depending on the product.**

**You must repeat the treatment after 7 days.**
