Please practise your **times tables** ready for the times table test on **Monday**, and your **maths facts** ready for your test on **Friday**. This week the Friday test will be on **6.5 – doubles and halves of two digit decimals**. **Example : What is half of 12.36 ? You need to be careful with decimals where the hundredths digit is an odd number.**

Read the appropriate sections in your maths revision book, then work through the questions in your maths and SPAG books. The answers will be discussed in class so you need to remember to bring your maths books to your maths class
