




## Weekly Home Learning Tasks

What is the object? What terrible thing will happen if the magic is started? What starts the magic? Who can stop it and how?	Watch episode 7 of "The Legend of the Lost Keys."  In this episode, the box is finally opened. It is a magical moment. Write a short description of what happens. Start when Janus turned the last key and finish with the people staring at the huge doorway in front of them. Use powerful noun phrases and maybe a simile to make it sound magical. P.E.	<p>Start the week off well- do the Joe Wicks workout either live at 9 am or watch the video later.
