Ask children questions; Who are the main characters? What did the bear make? Why did the bears decide to go for a walk? What did Goldilocks do first? What did she do next? What was the last thing she did?</p> <p>Help your child to write down all their ideas in the home learning book. Use the sentence starters to help you:</p> <p>The main characters Are..... The bears made..... The bears decided to.... First Goldilocks... Next Goldilocks..</p>

Task 2 - Get your child to act like Goldilocks and use language/words she uses in the story "It is too hot yuck, it's just right" I am hungry, I am tired"

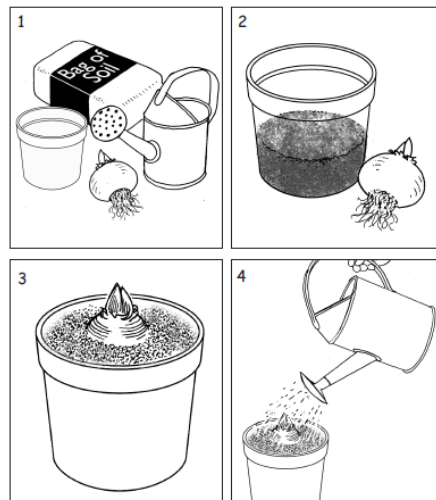
Get your child to draw and label all the things Goldilocks did. For example the three bowls (hot, cold, just right), three chairs (too hard, too soft, just right) and the three beds.

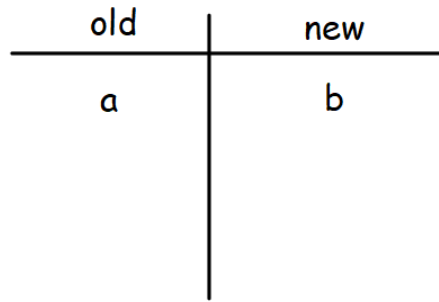
