

## **MATHS ANSWERS: Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020 – Mental Addition**

Use these cards to make 5 different addition problems using 2-digit and 3-digit numbers.  
Show your working out:



ANSWERS WILL VARY E.g.  $23 + 764 = 787$

### **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2020 – Arithmetic**

$$\begin{array}{lllll} 1024 - 100 = 924 & 68 \times 5 = 340 & 2.6 + 0.5 = 3.1 & 4838 = 4702 + 136 & 6^2 + 7 = 43 \\ 1.3 \times 1000 = 1300 & 594 \div 6 = 99 & \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{4} & 6 \times 3 \times 4 = 72 & \end{array}$$

### **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2020 – Mental Addition**

Butterflies can fly great distances. Use **mental** strategies to calculate at least 5 journeys.

ANSWERS WILL VARY E.g. Villa to Seaport to Effe =  $45\text{km} + 235\text{km} = 280\text{km}$

### **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2020 - Arithmetic**

$$\begin{array}{lllll} 564 - 300 = 264 & 901 + 100 = 1001 & 756 \div 10 = 75.6 & 300 \times 9 = 2700 & 2 + 6 \times 4 = 26 \\ 20\% \text{ of } 250 = 50 & \frac{6}{8} - \frac{2}{8} = \frac{4}{8} \text{ OR } \frac{1}{2} & 25 \times 6 = 150 & 3408 - 573 = 2835 & \end{array}$$

### Answers for the text Cloud Swing

1. What is the name of the girl in the story?  
**Her name is Margherita.**
2. What is the name of the street/road where the girl lives?  
**The street was called Via San Gratiliano.**
3. What job does the girl's mother do? Explain how you know.  
**Her mother's job was a teacher. We know this because it says in the text that her mother 'wasn't going to school either' and that she was 'interacting with her children from her computer' which shows her mother was also doing home-learning with her class, just like we are.**
4. Name the cities that the girl flies over.  
**The girl flies over the seaside area but the cities are Cortina, Venezia (also known as Venice), and Florence.**
5. What are the two mountain ranges mentioned in the story?  
**The two mountain ranges are called, the Dolomites and the Apennine Mountains.**
6. Where does the girl first see any sign of people? What are they doing?  
**The girl first sees people in Venezia (Venice) who are queuing at the fishmonger's stall.**

### **Challenge questions**

1. The people that the girl sees in the story are clearly keeping away from each other. This has been called 'social distancing'. What is clearly different about the rules for social distancing in Italy and the rules in England?  
**We find out that when people are queuing at the fishmongers in Venezia, they are standing one metre apart but in the UK, our social-distancing is two metres.**
2. The story includes the Italian word for 'goodbye'. What is it?  
**The Italian word for goodbye is, 'arrivederci'.**
