- 70 5. Mix the chillies into the jelly liquid.
- 79 6. Carefully, pour the jelly liquid into a mould.
- 88 7. Pop the mixture into the fridge to set.
- 100 8. To serve, pour hot sauce over the top of the jelly.

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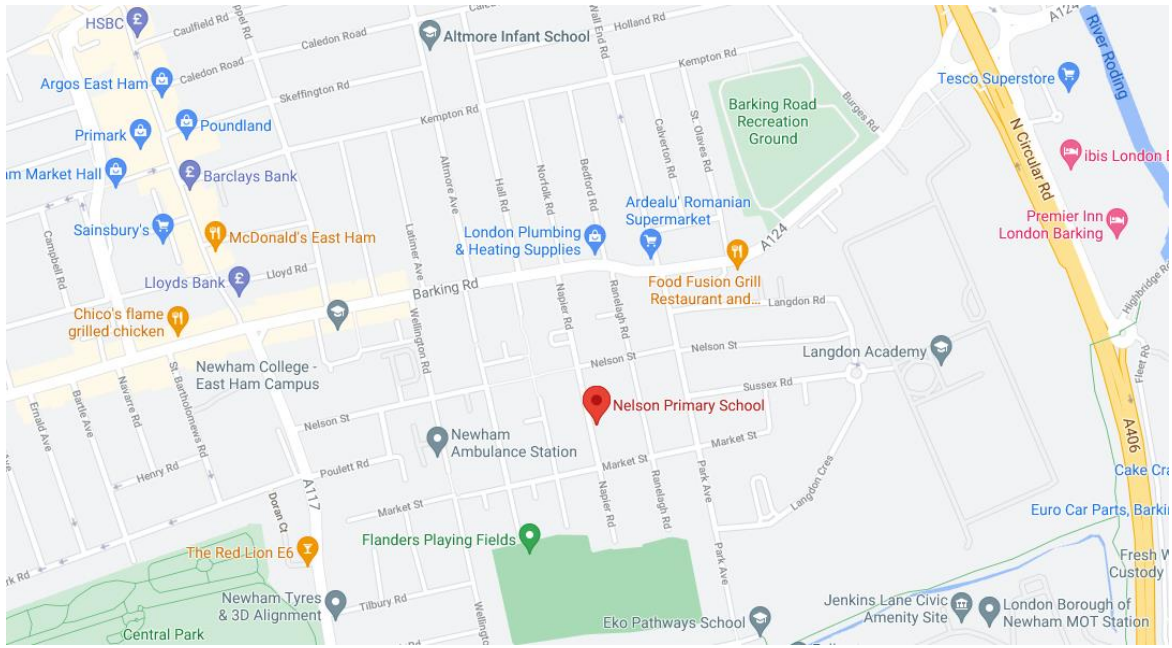
