Reading Comprehension - Snakes

Snakes are a kind of reptile, which means they have cold blood and scales. Some snakes are as small as a coin and some are as long as a bus! Pythons are a type of snake. Pythons like to live in places that are warm. They need to live in warm places because they have cold blood, which means they are found in deserts and jungles.
