Basic Maths facts to learn: Bonds of multiples of 10 up to 100

$10 + \underline{\quad} = 100$	$70 + \underline{\quad} = 100$
$40 + \underline{\quad} = 100$	$\underline{\quad} + 20 = 100$
$100 + \underline{\quad} = 100$	$\underline{\quad} + 90 = 100$
$90 \text{ add } \underline{\quad} = 100$	$50 \text{ plus } \underline{\quad} = 100$
$30 \text{ plus } \underline{\quad} = 100$	$10 + \underline{\quad} = 100$
