- (1) Partition the biggest number
- (2) Find the pair that is the most efficient one (using doubles)
- (3) Complete the calculation.

Ms Mustafa/ Ms Stopps / Mr Malji groups: This week you need to apply the measure facts from last year to answer these questions in your books : How many mm in 5 cm? How many ml in 10 litres? How many grams in 13 kilograms? How many kilograms in 4000grams? How many kilograms in 40 grams? Continue to learn squared numbers and prime numbers.
