Due to pupils being educated within bubbles, sports clubs were limited, but were able to take place for single year groups. Sports activities at break and lunch times were increased, albeit within smaller sectioned off areas of the playground. Pupil fitness was an issue after returning from lockdown, so a focus of the PE sessions and lunchtime activities were based around improved fitness.

Sports days took place within year groups, rather than cross key stage. The sports days were still competitive and pupils competed for their houses.
