Comprehension

Read the short text and answer the questions related to it. This week's questions are all to do with nouns and verbs. Remember that a noun is the name of a person, place or thing. Nouns have articles (a, an, or the) before them. A verb is an action word that can be made into an 'ing' word - example walk (walking), think, (thinking). Many words can be used as either nouns or verbs and that is what this comprehension is all about.
