Reading

Maths

Please practise your *times tables* and your *maths facts* ready for your Monday maths fluency: Mr DesRoches' group: Learn your 11 and 12 times tables and division facts. Practise these and ask your parents to test you before the Monday test. Ms Mustafa/ Ms Stopps / Mr Malji groups: As we are doing decimals, we would like you to make sure you know, or can work out, fraction and decimal equivalents. Decimals will always have a denominator of 10, 100 or 1000. If you have a fraction with a different denominator you need to make it into 10, 100 or 1000 by multiplication, remembering that whatever you do to the bottom you must also do to the top. Then you can find the decimal equivalent. Example : $3/5 = 6/10 = 0.6$
