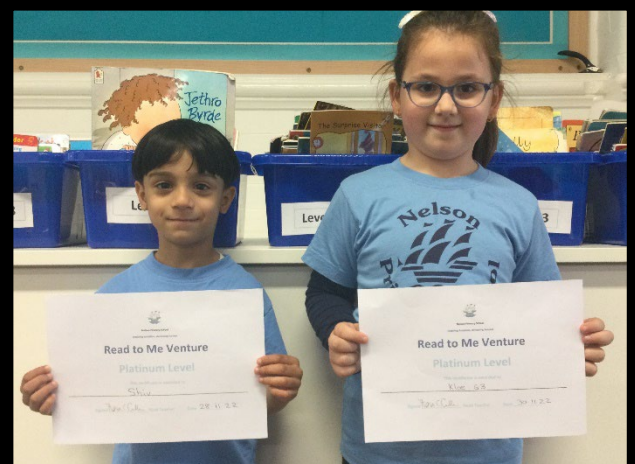
East Ham Library Visits

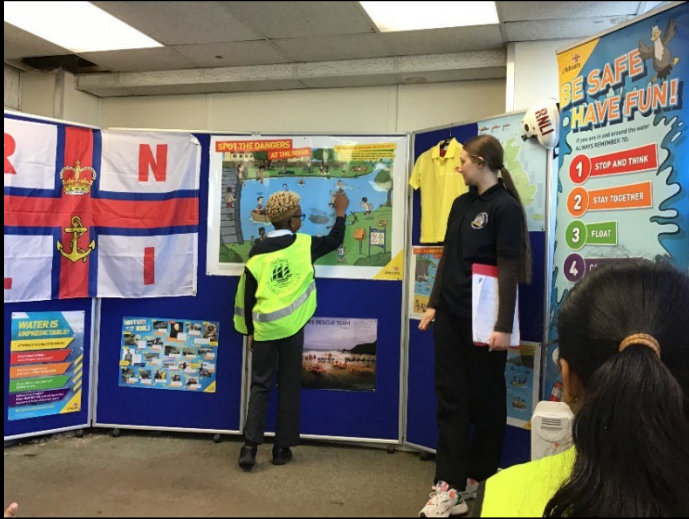
Read to Me Venture
