Dear Parents and Carers

We have had a lovely week. The year 2 children led an assembly all about Chinese New Year. This was full of drama and colour! I know the parents who attended really enjoyed the performance and then they got to learn some Mandarin phrases – Xinnian kuai le.

We were privileged to receive £!000 worth of books as part of a gift to the New Vision Trust from Brian Peppiatt (the father of our Chair of Trustees) – On Thursday Ms Butt and I took 8 children to Downshall Primary School (The newest school to join our trust) for a book festival to celebrate the gift of the books. 


Xinnian Kuai le
