Spring 2022

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English:

During the Spring Term, we will be exploring a short animation called 'Run', reading the Railway Children and reading, writing and performing a range of poetry. We will be doing a range of different writing outcomes.

Maths:

In the Spring Term, we will be focusing on Multiplication and Division. You can support your child at home by making sure they know their 2, 5 and 10 times table from Year 2 and their 3, 4 and 8 times tables in Year 3. They can use Times Tables Rockstars or Sum Dog to help them practice.

How you can support at home:

- Read with your child everyday.
- Practise times tables with your child.
- Use Letter Join resources to help practice handwriting at home.
- Use Spelling Shed to help your child learn their spellings.

We have been exploring what makes an effective learner and so you could ask your child the following questions:

- What did you learn today at school?
- Tell me about a strategy you used to help you with your learning.
- What challenged you the most today?

LCC:

History: Our topic for this term is 'How has the Victorian period shaped the East Ham that we live in today?' - We will be looking at how the area has changed over time. To support with this, we will have a Victorian drama workshop **on Monday 23rd January**.

Science: Our topic is Light, Sources and Shadows.

DT: Children will be designing and making their own photo frames out of wood.

RE: How do Jews and Hindus celebrate religious festivals?
