

#### How you can support at home

- Read with your child everyday.
- Encourage your child to write lists and short sentences.
- Count objects with your child. We have been exploring what makes an effective learner and so you could ask your child the following questions:
  - What did you *learn* today at school?
  - Tell me about a strategy you used to help you with your learning.
  - What challenged you the most today?

#### Read to me Venture

We ask all families to take part in our Read to Me venture.

- Read daily to your child.
- As you read a book, list it in your Read to Me booklet.
- You will be invited to attend a special assembly to see Mrs Cullen present your child with a reading certificate.
- There are five levels: Copper, Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum.
- Your child's school library book that can be used for the read to me venture, however not their class reading book.

We will award certificates for each level.
