English

During the Autumn term, we will be reading the following books: *Burglar Bill*, *Beegu* and *Where the Wild Things Are*. Based on these texts, we will write a postcard, instructions and a recount.

Maths

In the Autumn term, we will be deepening our understanding of numbers up to 100, comparing and ordering numbers and exploring number patterns. Year 2 children also need to add and subtract numbers up to 100.

How you can support at home

- Read with your child everyday.
- Encourage your child to write sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- Help your child to practice mental addition and subtraction within 10.

We have been exploring what makes an effective learner and so you could ask your child the following questions:

- What did you *learn* today at school?
- Tell me about a strategy you used to help you with your learning.
- What challenged you the most today?

In History, our learning challenge questions are:
Was the Great Fire of London really great?
Do all heroes wear capes?
(Significant people from the past)

In Science, our learning challenge questions are:
Which materials did they use to build the Olympic stadium? (Uses of everyday materials)
What do I need to be healthy?
(Animals inc habitats)
