Reading

Reading - Please read aloud to an adult every day. Please record in your reading record book the pages that you have read each day. **Remember to bring your book and reading record to school every day.** Please visit Nelson School Library for your reading books.

Maths

Maths fluency: This week we would like you to make sure you know the names of different 2D shapes. There are 3 different types of triangles: **scalene**, all sides different, **equilateral**, all sides the same and **isosceles**= two sides the same and one different. A 4-sided shape is a **quadrilateral**, if all sides are the same it is a **square**, if 2 sets of the same sides it is a **rectangle**. A 5-sided shape is a **pentagon**, a 6-sided shape is a **hexagon** and a 7-sided shape is a **heptagon**, an 8-sided shape is an **octagon**, a 9-sided shape is a **nonagon**.

Log on to Maths Shed and do some calculations to support your maths work in school.

Spelling - your spelling words (words with unstressed vowels) :

1. You must ensure you know the meaning of the word. -use a dictionary to help.
