Reading

Reading - Please read aloud to an adult every day. Please record in your reading record book the pages that you have read each day. Remember to bring your book and reading record to school every day. Please visit Nelson School Library for your reading books.

Maths

Maths fluency: This week we would like you to make sure you know what the different triangles are: equilateral = all the sides are the same length, isosceles = two sides the same length and one different, scalene = all sides of different lengths. Also, learn the following: all the internal angles of a triangle add up to 180 degrees, a 4 sided shape = quadrilateral, 5 sides = pentagon, 6 sides = hexagon, 7 sides = heptagon, 8 sides = octagon, 9 sides = nonagon. The different angles: acute = less than 90 degrees, obtuse = more than 90 degrees but less than 180, reflex = more than 180 degrees.

Log on to Maths Shed and do some calculations to support your maths work in school.

Spelling - your spelling words (year 5 and 6 curriculum words):

1. You must **ensure you know the meaning of the word.** -use a dictionary to help.
2. Write a sentence for each of the words. Only one word per sentence and the sentence should show you know the meaning of the word. **You must use the actual word.**
