Reading

Reading - Please read aloud to an adult every day. Please record in your reading record book the pages that you have read each day. Remember to bring your book and reading record to school every day. Please visit Nelson School Library for your reading books during the holiday.

Maths

Maths fluency: This week we would like you to make sure you look back over all your homework books and the maths fluency we have asked you to learn since the beginning of the year. Your test after the Easter holiday will be on anything we have asked you to learn for the maths fluency tests since September.

Log on to Maths Shed and do some calculations to support your maths work in school.

Spelling - your spelling words (words with the letter string acc): accommodate accompany access accuse accost accrue accuracy accomplish accentuate

- 1. You must ensure you know the meaning of the word. -use a dictionary to help.
- 2. Write a sentence for each of the words. Only one word per sentence and the sentence should show you know the meaning of the word. You must use the actual word.
- 3. Practise the spelling words ready for the spelling test on Tuesday next week.

Log on to Spelling Shed and practise your spellings.

Comprehension: During the Easter holiday, we expect you to complete 3 comprehensions in your reading comprehension book. You should complete the following ones: Fiction - page 8 The wind in the willows, Non-fiction - page 24, Beamish the living museum of the North, and Poetry- page 44 A swimmer in my dreams. You should also read your reading revision guide to help you with the different questions.
