## Maths

**Maths fluency:** This week we would like you to answer the maths problems on the sheet provided to you.

Your test next week will again focus on shape, angles, area and perimeter and prime numbers.

1. You must ensure you know the meaning of the word. -use a dictionary to help.
2. Write a sentence for each of the words. Only one word per sentence and the sentence should show you know the meaning of the word. **You must use the actual word.**
3. **Practise the spelling words ready for the spelling test on Tuesday next week.**
